
# The Chase Is On

and not afraid to have a little fun.

t just under 50 feet long and 15 feet wide, the Boston Boatworks Daychaser 48 is the perfect size for adventures as a day tender or primary vessel—small enough to maneuver easily, while big enough to accommodate 12 guests and all the gear and provisions required. The Daychaser 48 was originally designed for the Barton & Gray Mariners Club. Naval architect Doug Zurn set out to deliver the ultimate day boat and on-water entertaining platform. Highlights include an ideal deck layout for socializing in four separate zones—the bow lounge for sunning, the pilothouse bar for prepping and serving libations and food, the aft deck's chaise lounges for putting your feet up and kicking back, and the beach club on the stern for watersports and easy access to the water. Each area is thoughtfully designed with fun, accessibility, and safety in mind.

Below deck, you will find a generous head with full shower, an owner's desk, plenty of stowage for toys and accessories, and a daybed for the occasional nap or deliveries. Everyone knows that the kitchen is the entertainment center of the house, and it's no different on the Daychaser 48, with a layout that places the galley in the pilothouse, allowing seamless crew and guest interaction. The helm is designed for ease of use, with all the needed controls conveniently located, while our optional joystick control system makes docking and maneuvering a breeze.

Commercial-grade 550-horsepower Cummins QSB6.7 diesels coupled to HamiltonJet Drives propel the 48 to a cruise speed of 21 knots and a top speed of 26 knots. Additional mechanical systems include a generator and electrical system suited for military use. As for safety, USCG Certification provides robust firefighting, weather avoidance, drainage, and monitoring systems. All of this is paired with the Boston Boatworks team of technicians, electricians, engineers, and artisans, and our decades of composite construction experience.

The Boston Boatworks Daychaser 48's main deck is designed for entertaining in elegance, without compromising on seaworthiness, functionality or safety. The helm has everything you'd expect on a vessel of this caliber—the latest in navigational technology, thoughtfully placed controls, and an unencumbered line of sight through the single-pane windshield. The helm deck seating welcomes guests and surrounds them in airy, natural light thanks to an abundance of thoughtfully-palced opening windows. Easy passage from the cockpit (also replete with comfortable seating) through the salon to the bow's seating area provides the perfect platform for greeting guests, sunset cruises, or exploring new harbors. Belowdecks, there is a large head with a shower, a day bed, and plenty of stowage for everything that needs to come aboard.

#### **BE OUR GUEST**

Each Daychaser 48 is USCG certified for 12 passengers and built to ISO Cat A and ABYC standards. The exterior is designed and built for reduced maintenance, incorporating faux painted exterior trim that is indistinguishable from real timber. The cockpit features a lounging area with dual L-Shaped settees, forward and aft facing settees, and easy access to the swim platform. Moving about is effortless thanks to wide walk-throughs and an open-concept layout. Forward, the bow area, accessible through a thoughtful passageway to the port of the helm, features two tables and a large, wrap-around settee. Not only does the profile and finish complement any superyacht, custom soft goods décor packages are also available. The Boston Boatworks staff has deep experience working with captains and managers on engineering and creating towing and lift packages for day tenders and support vessels.
