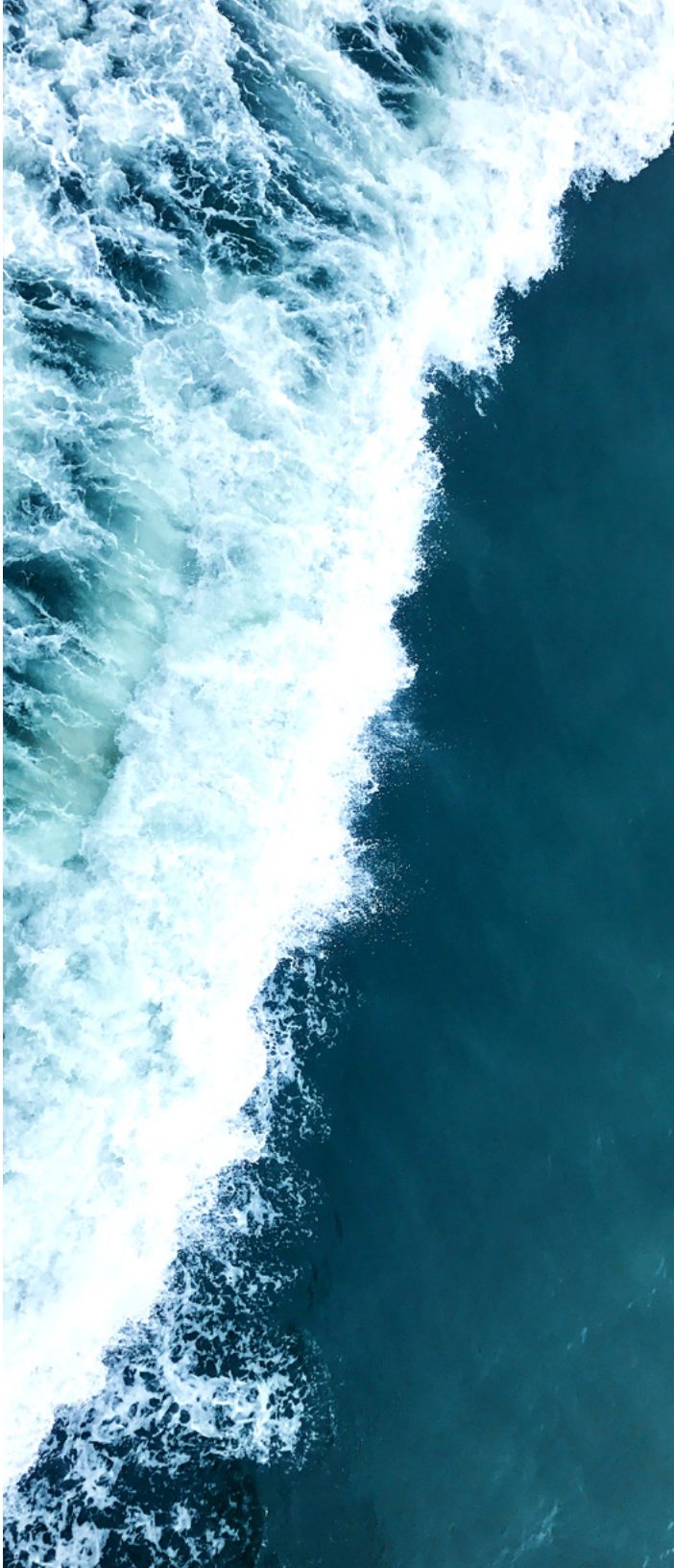

Our vision for success has always been measured by the relationships we build.

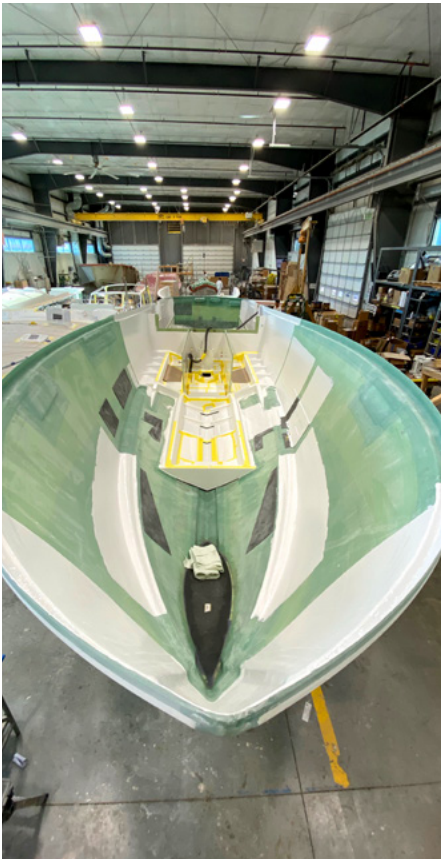

Boston Boatworks was founded in 1996 to advance high-tech composite construction methods along with the proven building excellence culture of Lindsay Boatbuilders. Our mission was to expand the applications for these skills to include categories of vessels beyond the all-out raceboats of our origins. Focusing on strength-to-weight ratios, toughness, and the durability advantages of our proprietary small-batch pre-preg composite process, allowed us to deliver boats for passionate customers who shared our belief in what makes a true ocean-worthy yacht.

This strategy presented us with the opportunity to add the process controls to meet quality-assurance standards required for ISO CAT A yachts, and USCG-inspected builds of certified commercial passenger vessels. The types of owners who wanted this expertise from us also required their yacht to have the same quality in their vessel's cabinetry, innovative onboard systems, fit and finish, and the ongoing owner and vessel support that we are known for today.

For Boston Boatworks' first design built under our own name, we chose to turn our teams' skills loose by building a boat that best expresses the values our journey has taught us. The BB52 Offshore Express Cruiser was conceived, designed, and built for heavy weather passages, and appointed for relaxing at the remote anchorage an ocean-worthy yacht makes possible.

SUPPORT

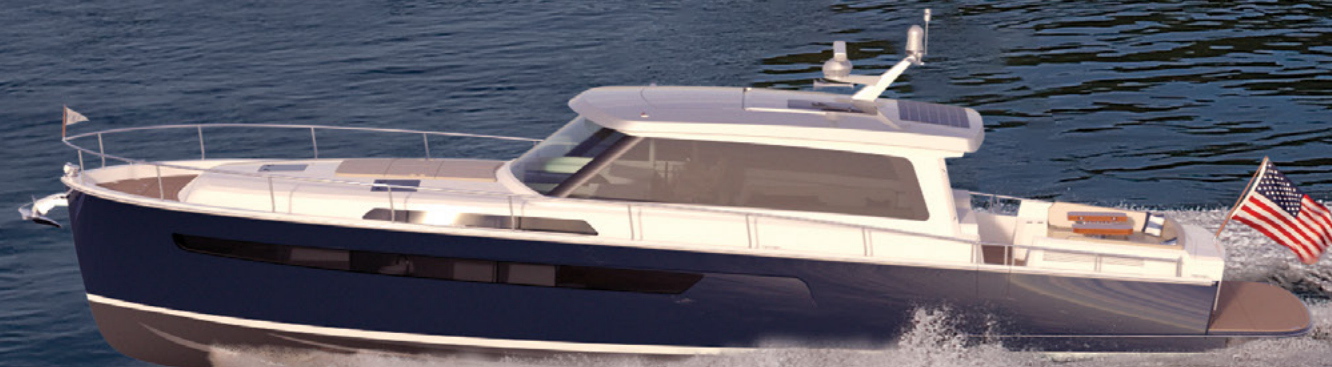
Supporting the enjoyment of time on the water aboard the boats we build is why we are fortunate enough to have so many repeat customers.

When an owner takes delivery of a Boston Boatworks-built boat, it is not the end of our relationship, but the *beginning*. This is the stage when our Customer Care Team takes the lead. For instance, New Owner Orientation, one of the services we offer, is a two-day affair that launches you with everything you need to know about piloting, operating, and maintaining your boat.

And once your boat leaves our dock, the support continues—our Customer Care Team supports all of the boats we've built, in perpetuity. Factory-trained specialists are available to every owner, so you know you are not alone if an issue arises. We are also there for brush-up questions, help with a vendor, warranty coverage, service, repair, up-fit, refit, off-season storage, parts replacement, and local yard support.

Perfection Took 27 Years

The Boston Boatworks commitment to building high-tech, offshore-capable performance yachts has come to a full crescendo with the launch of the BB52.



After nearly three decades of building hundreds of composite boats between 29 and 62 feet, including MJMs, custom sailboats, expedition tenders, and Coast Guard Certified passenger vessels, Boston Boatworks is entering into its most exciting phase. It all started with customers saying, “I love using my boat, but I want to go further.” While our skilled team was crafting high-quality, high-performing, ocean-rated yachts for knowledgeable boat owners, we’ve always wondered, “what if we remove ourselves from our own echo chamber, and base a new boat design not on what has been done, but what *can be done*?” The answer came with a singular, bold reply: the new BB52.

The BB52 is more than a yacht. It represents all that a boat can be, in terms of construction, luxury, safety, performance, and functionality. In many ways, it’s the boat we’ve been thinking about since our founding, and it reflects our collective experience and that of our owners as well. Moreover, it embodies the lessons learned from our 24-year trusted partnership with Doug Zurn, a naval architect known for designs that turn heads, soften waves, and are equally at home delivering families to a beach or a far-flung offshore destination. Into this proven collaboration, we are adding the spatial mastery and materials sophistication of Winch Design, the internationally renowned design studio responsible for creating the exteriors and interiors of some of the world’s most iconic superyachts, private aircraft, and residential properties. Bringing more than 35 years of experience to the project, Winch Design created a contemporary yet timeless interior for the BB52 that is light, spacious, and in line with our core values of durability, comfort, and ergonomics. Together with Zurn, Winch developed interior configurations to incorporate a multitude of elegant and clever features that will make both the journey and destination equally enjoyable.

SAFETY FIRST

The emphasis on safety and functionality are immediately apparent when boarding the BB52. Eight-inch bulwarks surround the walkaround decks flowing from the stern to the cockpit, keeping feet securely on deck while underway. Note the grab rail concealed under the coach house edge—another detail that reflects the builder’s and designer’s embrace of form and function. The decks can be finished with painted non-skid, or with optional composite “teak” decking, shown here.



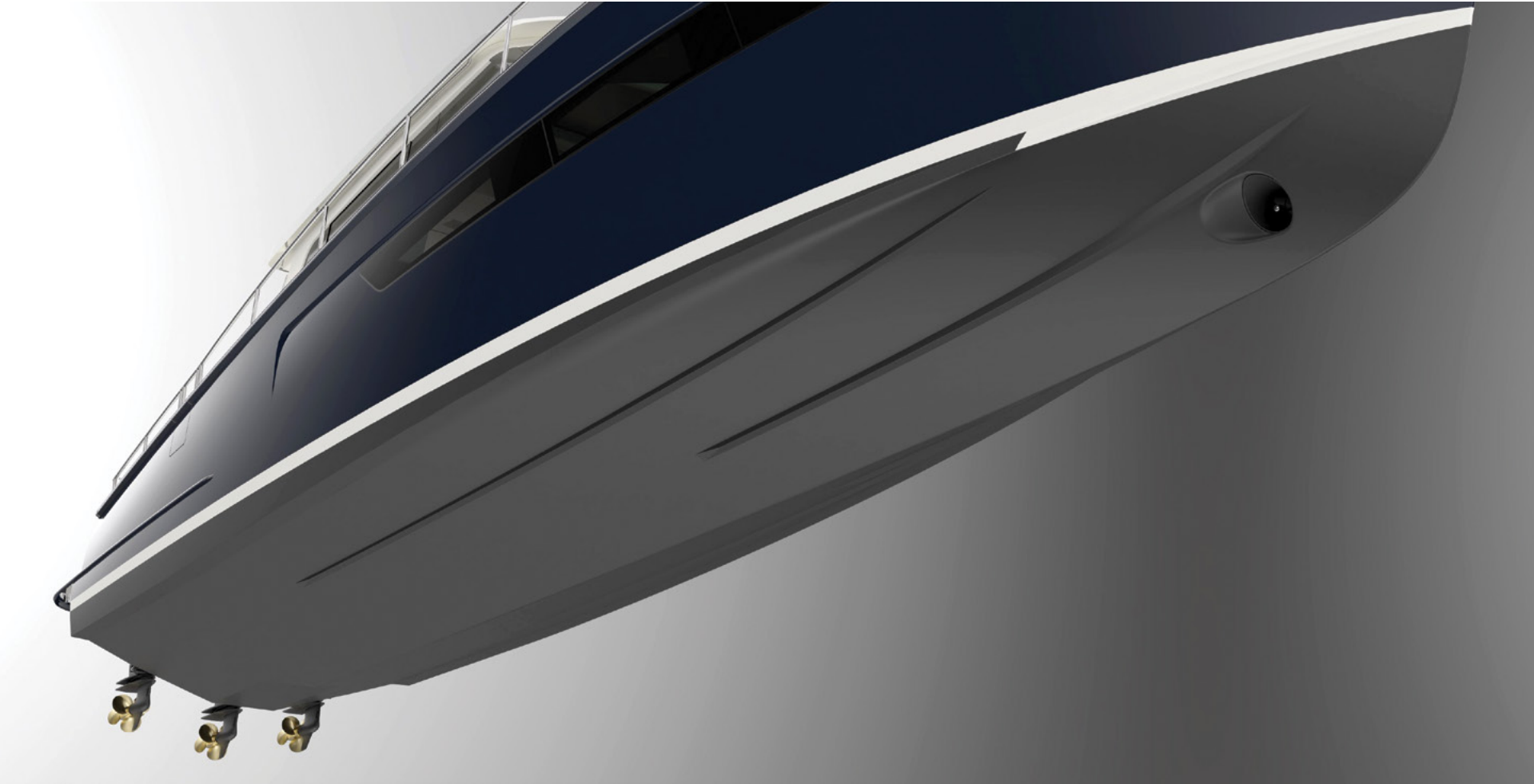
ROOM TO ROAM

Wide side decks with two transom gates to the large swim platform flank the U-shaped settee, delivering a walk-around cockpit that allows for easy access to the stern cleats and transom. The U-shaped seating is placed inboard of the coach house for offshore passagemaking safety and comfort. The cockpit can also be completely covered by an awning system to create an additional covered entertainment and living space that seamlessly joins to the saloon area.



EXTERIOR STYLING AND FUNCTION

The BB52’s exterior styling reflects the longstanding and very successful collaboration between Boston Boatworks and Doug Zurn, of Zurn Yacht Design. “I always say that a boat has to be timeless in design, whether it was designed in the ‘30s or designed today,” said Zurn. “It doesn’t involve smoke and mirrors. It’s real style. The BB52 design is the culmination of years of experience building lightweight, efficiently driven powerboats combined with contemporary, timeless styling to appeal to discriminating yachtsmen both here and abroad.” A significant focus was made on joining the interior and exterior spaces to expand liveability and add to the way the BB52 can truly be enjoyed.



HULL DESIGN

The BB52 incorporates all the trademarks of a Zurn Yacht Design high-efficiency hull beneath the waterline to amplify offshore safety and comfort—a moderate dead-rise angle of 19 degrees coupled with a narrow waterline beam facilitates a dry, safe, economical, and comfortable ride for all those onboard. Additionally, the hull incorporates a quiet chine, which helps dissipate wave slap in displacement mode. Topsides, the BB52 is a departure from Zurn’s past, in that the design incorporates a reverse sheer, increasing the available interior volume and providing a dry ride offshore. The BB52’s plumb bow and tumblehome stern are hallmark traits of a Zurn design. And while the BB52 has a stately presence at rest, this is a hull that wants to get up and go—with the hammers down, she boasts a top speed of 40 knots.

Designed with owner-operators in mind, the BB52 offers easy access to outside from the helm, through a full-height door to the protected sidedecks, where eight-inch bulwarks and safety rails extend from bow to stern.





WELCOME HOME

The winning combination of Zurn Yacht Design, Winch Design, and Boston Boatworks is on full display within the interior of the BB52. The flexible layout allows for a galley-down arrangement, shown here, or a galley-up layout which allows for an additional state-room on the starboard side. Regardless of the layout chosen, the abundance of light and air comes standard. Winch Design created the space to be bright, spacious, and elegant, incorporating a multitude of intelligent details to enhance the lifestyle.

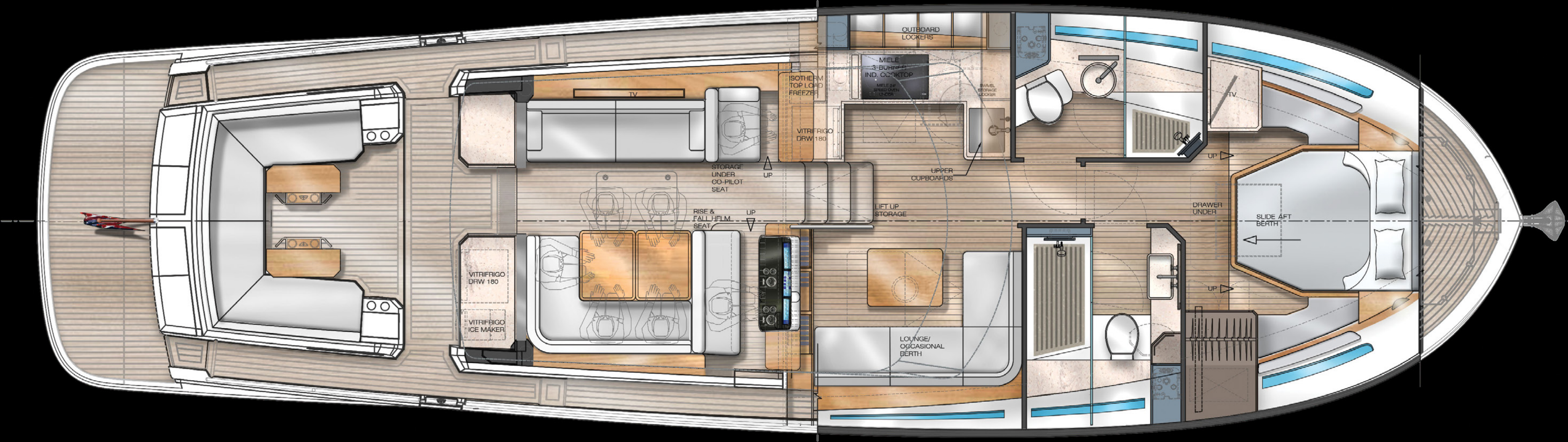
